RULES AND REGULATIONS

Preamble

These Rules and Regulations are supplementary to the requirements of the Use Agreement and also apply on Olifants North Game Reserve when you are traversing there as a Member or User of Olifants River Game Reserve.

Please familiarise yourself with these Rules and Regulations as well as the Reciprocal Traversing Agreement. Authorised users and guests, as well as their visitors, are required to abide by these Rules and Regulations at all times and it is the responsibility of the Member, Representative Shareholder, or Authorised User, as the case may be, must ensure that their guests and visitors comply with all of the rules, regulations and protocols of the reserve.. Most of the Rules are obvious, particularly to those who have a real interest in the bush, as they are based on ecological principles and consideration for the environment, other members and users. Adherence will in no way inhibit enjoyment of our Reserves; on the contrary it should be enhanced for all. These rules are designed to provide for the safety of all on the reserve, their peace and consideration of others.

Access and Indemnity

All persons (members, users, guests, staff and building contractors), other than management and employees of the Reserve, must complete and sign the indemnity form provided when accessing the Reserve through one of the Control Gates. Persons arriving by aircraft must present themselves at the Office before proceeding to their unit in order to sign the arrival and indemnity forms.

Walking on the Reserve

Walking, for safety reasons, is currently not permitted along the river, along trails or anywhere in the bush.

- Never walk in front of units or on the flood plains along the river. Units belonging to other members (and their immediate environs) are private and this privacy must be respected at all times.

Tracking of animals on foot is not permitted.

- Be careful when walking around your unit, particularly at night. Remember that lion, buffalo, leopard, hippo, rhino and elephant, as well as snakes and scorpions, are all potentially dangerous.

Litter/Refuse/Noise

Do not litter. Please remove any litter you may come across.

Refuse is not to be stored outside your unit unless secured in a suitable (baboon proof) receptacle.

Please sort your refuse into combustible waste (in black bags) and glass and tins (using plastic bags other than black) for recycling purposes. Refuse must be placed **INSIDE** the appropriate container at a **designated refuse site**.

- The collection or removal of wood or any other plant matter or part thereof, animals, animal parts or other movable component of the Reserve is prohibited.

Quiet and consideration for others at all times is essential. Always be aware of the effect of noise, use of lighting and litter on fellow members and the ecology. Inconsiderate, careless and reckless driving will not be tolerated, whilst the use of radios, mobile phones and other appliances can be particularly intrusive.

Driving on the Reserve

Only one game viewing vehicle per unit may be on a game drive at any one time.

The game viewing vehicle must conform to the normal standard of such a vehicle (refer to the Game Viewing Vehicle Policy).

No persons are permitted on tracker seats or on the front bonnet of the vehicle. The game viewer vehicle must be configured to seat all passengers and it is incumbent on the member/user to ensure that all passengers are safely seated in the vehicle while in motion.

Children may not sit on the lap of the driver, whether operating the vehicle or not.

Members and Users are urged to familiarise themselves with the layout and boundaries of the farm and not to enter neighbouring properties, other than Olifants North Game Reserve, which is subject to a Reciprocal Traversing Agreement. Maps of both properties are available on the Website and are for sale in the Office.

Only licensed drivers may drive or be in control of a vehicle on the Reserve.

Private vehicles may not be used for game viewing without the prior consent of the Warden. In the event of such permission being granted, the unit number must be displayed on the sides and back of the vehicle.

Maintain a discreet distance from game and do not drive off-road for any reason whatsoever.

To preserve our roads do not exceed the speed limit of 30 Kph and use 4-wheel drive where designated. You may not drive in river beds other than at designated and demarcated points.

Vehicles must be maintained in good working order and must not be excessively noisy or smoky.

Be considerate of others when using spotlights. When in the vicinity of units, spotlights should be extinguished or directed away from houses.

Game viewer vehicles must display the unit number on both sides and at the rear in a manner, size and colour approved by the management of the Reserve.

Do not blind any animals or birds with your spotlights. Red filters are compulsory for close game viewing.

- Vehicles may operate no more than two standard type hand held spotlights. LED spotlights, must not illuminate more than an equivalent of a 100 watt conventional halogen globe
- The use of Laser Pointers as a means of indicating the position of game is strictly prohibited.

Waterholes

- Do not drive or park closer than 50m to a waterhole other than where a road or parking area approaches the water within that limit.

Be quiet and respectful of others. This includes the discreet use of radios.

Use of mobile phones should be discreet at all times so as to not interfere with others or game.

Refrain from alighting from your vehicle within 200 metres of a dam or waterhole; this disturbs the game and is unsightly.

General

No exotic flora or fauna, including household pets of any description, may be brought onto the Reserve.

The provision of nesting boxes, feeding trays and bird baths, whilst prevalent, is not desirable. You are encouraged not to install them and if you do have them, to remove them as they attract fauna, particularly baboons and monkeys, to the units.

No hunting, shooting, fishing, capture, snaring, chasing, teasing, feeding or luring (by recordings or otherwise) of any fauna is permitted.

Do not engrave, carve, deface or mark any part of the Reserve, living or otherwise.

- All charges incurred during a visit must be paid for at the Office before departing from the Reserve.

Picnicking is prohibited other than at designated viewpoints/ picnic sites.

No boats, caravans, bicycles, motorised cycles or quad bikes are permitted

- Overflow guests are not permitted to use the clubhouse cottage
- Drones, robots and the likes are prohibited

Gas braais may be used at areas designated by the directors from time to time. Wood and charcoal fires are not permitted, other than at the clubhouse and at the appropriate place at your unit.

- Control fires carefully and do not leave fires or live embers burning when leaving your boma. Do not place warm ash in plastic refuse bins or bags. Please prevent veld fires.

Camping is not permitted. Overnighting is permitted at certain hides but Management must be advised in advance of the stay.

Owners of aircraft must not buzz units or the office area to announce their arrival. Aircraft must maintain an altitude that ensures that there is no disturbance to visitors or the game on the Reserve.

The use of generators and power plants at units is not permitted.

External or deck electric and gas lighting is not permitted and may not be installed unless the lighting is shaded or screened in a manner approved by the Board. Please ensure that internal electric or gas lighting does not cause external light pollution or a nuisance to others. (See also the Building Regulations relating to Electricity). No fences, electric or otherwise, may be erected around units.

Swimming in the river or in dams is strictly prohibited.

- Please advise the Warden of any unusual sightings, especially fires, and in particular injured animals, trespassers, unmarked vehicles, potential poachers, unusual, suspicious and/ or low flying aircraft and thieves or anything else that you may consider a potential problem.

Respect the office hours and off-duty times of staff and management.

Remember to switch off gas and water supplies as well as all electric lights and air-conditioners before vacating and locking your unit.

I agree to abide by these rules and any amendments thereto as well as the regulations stipulated in the Use Agreement and the Reciprocal Traversing Agreement with Olifants North Game Reserve.
